### 2. LOCATION AND DRIVING DIRECTIONS

HMCS ONTARIO is located on the campus of the Royal Military College of Canada, Kingston, Ont.

- ➔ Route to the Kingston area via Highway 401 (MacDonald-Cartier Freeway); Exit 623 at Highway 15 (Kingston/Smiths Falls/CFB Kingston/Ft. Henry).
- ➔ Turn South and proceed 6.6 km to Highway 2.
- ➔ Turn West (right) and proceed 0.7 km to Fort Henry Drive.
- ➔ Turn South (left) onto Fort Henry Drive for approx. 100 m to Precision Drive, the main entrance to the Royal Military College of Canada and turn right.
- ➔ Stop at the gatehouse if requested; proceed 0.5 km to Gen Crerar Cres.
- ➔ Turn right and proceed 200 m to Valour Drive.
- ➔ Turn left and proceed 200 m to Amiens Avenue.
- ➔ On the South side of the parade square, look for the sign identifying Headquarters, HMCS ONTARIO.

### 3. REPORTING-IN

Reporting-in dress orders are:

Officers: 3B

Staff Cadets: C-2A (Sea), SC-2 (Army), C-7 (Air)

Civilian: Smart Casual (Shirts – collared or golf style; slacks – dress, khaki or cotton in good repair, not tattered; footwear – laced styles, clean and not tattered.)

### 4. KIT LIST ADDENDA

Additional quantities of solid-colour, civilian pattern shorts, or appropriate on-water gear, are recommended for wear during marine activities (Sailing courses, General Training courses), to be carried – not worn – to and from the waterfront.

Officers shall be prepared for the following orders of dress for various occasions:

1A, 2C, 3, 3B, 3C, 5. Officers may bring orders of dress 2/2A2B if desired; however there is no assurance they will be needed.

“Combats” and naval combats may be worn only when field/sea-training requirements dictate: the former will be available on temporary loan as required
