

- ➔ Turn South onto Bay Bridge Rd./CR 62 and proceed across the Bay Bridge toward Picton.
- ➔ Proceed 11.9 km to Silver Star Rd. and watch for signs identifying Canadian Forces Base Trenton Detachment Mountain View on the West (right) side of the road.
- ➔ Turn right onto Detachment property and obtain directions at the gatehouse. Map

5. KIT LIST ADDENDA

Note that uniform tunics are not required.

6. **MEDICAL**

Certain medical conditions are incompatible with flying duties. Parents must therefore be totally candid in providing complete disclosure of all of the cadet's medical conditions on their initial CF 51 APPLICATION AND APPROVAL – CADET ACTIVITIES form for review by the Central Region Medical Advisor, and to immediately advise of any medical changes in that may occur following submission of the CF 51. Undisclosed medical circumstances could result in the cadet being RTU since minimum medical standards must be maintained as a condition of holding a Transport Canada aircrew licence.

Any and all medications ingested must be approved by a Canadian Forces Flight Surgeon (where available) or a Transport Canada approved Canadian Aviation Medical Examiner. Similarly, ingesting unapproved or undocumented medication may result in RTU action.

7. **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE**

Although remote from the physical environment of a Cadet Summer Training Centre, Central Region's Gliding School is functionally similar, particularly in terms of cadet department. The regional Return to Unit (RTU) policy described in paragraph 54 of the [Regional Joining Instructions](#) is in force. Additional potential causes for Cease Training/RTU action during the Glider Scholarship course include:

- a. Failure of four ground school exams;
- b. Failure of a rewritten Transport Canada examination;
- c. Four unsatisfactory (failed) flights during the course; and
- d. Academic dishonesty.

8. **HONOURS AND AWARDS**

Significant achievement during the Glider Scholarship and Introduction to Aviation Courses will be recognized at graduating parades. The awards include:

- a. For the Glider Scholarship Course:
 - (1) Central Region Gliding Memorial Trophy and Advanced Soaring Award (Best Overall Pilot)
 - (2) LCol R.R. Massier Trophy (Best Pilot)
 - (3) Maj N. Cairns Trophy (Top Academic Pilot)
- b. OPC Flying Awards
 - (1) Trenton Chamber of Commerce Trophy (GPS Best Pilot Overall)
 - (2) Confederation Life Trophy (GPS Exemplary Flying Ability)
